1. PA Criminal Background Check

#### Option 1:

Do online at https://epatch.state.pa.us

Click on "Submit a new record check" then fill out application

Application Fee: \$22.00

Once clearance is received, send copy to the office.

2. Child Abuse History Clearance

#### Option 1:

Do online at https://www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis/public/home

"Create A New Account" and click "Next" enter information then click "Finish"

#### Option 2:

Fill out Child Abuse Form

Check "School" in the "Purpose of Clearance"

Application Fee: \$8.00

Once clearance is received, send copy to the office.

3. FBI Background Check

#### Option 1:

Register online at www.identogo.com

#### Option 2:

**Select Get Fingerprinted** 

Select Pennsylvania where it states "select a fingerprinting service by state"

Go to "Digital Fingerprinting" Enter Service Code: 1KG8RJ Enter Agency Code: 4205

Go to "Schedule and Manage Appointment"

Enter information asked through out application then enter zip code to locate a fingerprinting facility

Make an appointment or select walk -In Print or save receipt from registration.

Bring registration and chosen form of Identification selected from application when getting fingerprinted.

Once clearance is received, send a copy to the office.
